INFLUENZA VACCINE

Available free of charge to:

- ✓ Persons 60 years and older
- ✓ Healthy children 6 to 23 months of age, inclusive
- ✓ Children and teens (under age 18) on long-term acetylsalicylic acid (ASA) treatment
- ✓ Persons with a condition requiring regular medical follow-up or hospital care, such as heart disease, lung disease, respiratory problems or chronic health conditions
- ✓ Pregnant women with any of the above conditions (at any stage of pregnancy)
- ✓ Healthy pregnant women in their 2nd or 3rd trimester
- ✓ Persons likely to transmit influenza to people with a high risk of complications, such as health care workers, day care workers and people who live with or care for at-risk persons or children under 6 months of age

PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINE

Available free of charge to:

Pneumococcal vaccine 23 (Pneu-P-23) is available for:

- ✓ Persons 65 years and older
- ✓ Persons 2 to 64 years of age at high risk of pneumococcal infection, such as persons with a suppressed immune system, chronic kidney failure, asplenia or a chronic condition or disease

IMMUNIZATION CLINICS BY APPOINTMENT

In January 2017, immunization clinics will be available by appointment at the Aylmer, Gatineau and Hull CLSCs (local community service centres). Available appointment dates and times will be announced at a later date.
